

Steve Vai's

brilliant forays into new areas such as his strikingly different *Sextet* and *Religion* albums are more evidence that few things stay constant in his musical universe other than constant change. Fortunately, one other thing that has remained consistent is Steve Vai's continual experimentation with guitars and guitar concepts. This has been an invaluable asset to Ibanez R&D and to his JEM and Universe lines of guitars.

Another change for Steve is a simplified on-stage rig. This has placed more demands on his guitars. The addition of the alder-bodied JEM7VWH to the basswood-bodied JEM series expands the tonal capabilities of guitars already famous for a wide variety of sound colors.

1994 brings another important instrument to the JEM line, the JEM555. This "JEM Jr." utilizes the most identifying features of the well-established JEM line—a low profile tremolo, basswood body, comfortable JEM neck and trademarked "Ion's Claw" tremolo cavity—and packages them in an astonishingly affordable, no-compromise instrument.

Paul Gilbert, like many touring players, originally chose to play a non-trem guitar because he didn't have the luxury of a full time guitar tech. Locking tremolos are great, but they do take longer to restring...and Paul decided he didn't want to spend hours in his hotel every night restringing four or five guitars.

Now that Mr. Big is a platinum selling band, having a full time guitar tech is no longer a luxury. But Paul found that using a non-trem guitar made him more skilled at vibrato and enabled him to do his intricate double stop bends. With that in mind, Paul requested that the PGW500, his first full production model, be a "hard tail" guitar (previous models have been limited production models with double-locking trem). This new PGW500 features DiMarzio's Tone Zone® and Humbucker From Hell® pickups direct-mounted into a basswood body. With Split 5 wiring, fixed bridge and an All Access Neck Joint, the PGW500 is a super stable, very dynamic guitar. And because it's a guitar designed by a player capable of both fastastic styling and unbelievable speed, the PGW features the Bassz ultra-fast Wizard neck fitted with jumbo frets.

The PGW500 is also Bassz™ only guitar with a fixed bridge and a reverse headstock. These two features not only give the PGW500 a distinctly different look, they give it a distinctly different feel because both features affect the string tension. This is one of many reasons why guitarists in search of something different owe it to themselves to try out the PGW500.

USA Custom RG guitars feature highly figured flame maple or curly maple tops on older backs, and are fitted with direct-mounted DiMarzio® pickups. USA Custom RG tops are carefully crafted to the right thickness to provide the proper tonal balance between the older and maple portions of the body. And though we've added a maple top, USA Custom RG's still offer the same comfort cuts that make the RG body style so comfortable to play.

In what has to be termed the perfect marriage, the Ibanez All Access Neck Joint has been combined with FBC's ingenious Tension-Free® neck. FBC's unique design relieves the neck of all string tension for easier playing and allows the action to be set to a player's exact preference. It also features peerless stability, dramatically increased sustain, and no dead spots.

In answer to the increasingly varied needs of today's hard rock players, USA Custom RG's are also available in tremolo and fixed bridge versions. All these features combine to make Ibanez USA Custom RG guitars the finest crafted, best sounding American rock instruments ever made.

In 1987, the first RG550's appeared. In the years that followed, its basswood body, American designed pickups with SpinFive wiring, recessed Edge double-locking tremolo, and slim Wizard neck with jumbo frets inspired legions of players—as well as a host of imitators. However, none of the copies have ever come close to capturing the sound of the original or the level of player loyalty. In 1994, the RG550 retains the same features that have made it a resounding success and adds another advantage: Ibanez' famous All Access Neck Joint System.

For players desiring even more, the deluxe RG550LT features V7 and V8 pickups, sharktooth inlays, a matching minor pickguard and Cosmic Black hardware. Both the RG550 and the RG550LT are fitted with the Lo-Pro Edge tremolo, acclaimed by many as the best sounding, smoothest action double-locking tremolo system.

In order to bring the advantages of the RG to more players, the RG400 series has been expanded and a new even more affordable model, the RG270, has been created. RG400 series guitars are fitted with the new Ibanez Infinity pickups which were specifically designed to complement the RG400's resonant Axiom™ basswood bodies. The RG270 and all RG400 guitars feature the Wizard II, a neck with the same dimensions of the nut and 24th fret as the original Wizard, but with a slightly rounder fingerboard and 2mm deeper profile.

The RG400 series also features a new double-locking tremolo that is closer in feel to the traditional Floyd Rose licensed tremolos. The RG270 utilizes a new singlelocking tremolo system which offers greater simplicity as well as a stability that rivals many double-locking systems. To fully round out the RG line, this year we offer the first regular RG model with a fixed bridge, the RG470FR.

For 1994, three new colors are offered: Cayenne Green, Transparent Black (on the RG470FM), and Electric Blue.

Ton between technology and tradition? Modern instruments offer the stability of double-locking tremolos and more tonal variety...but traditional guitars are often simpler to use and are frequently preferred for double-stopping, country, and blues playing.

So, you have a choice: buying two "cheap" guitars, one modern and one "vintage" to cover all of your music bases...or getting one expensive guitar that can handle everything at an affordable price!

The RX series was created for the player that doesn't need a locking trem, but wants the performance and sound of a modern guitar with a traditional feeling neck and body. RX guitars feature non-locking tremes with many models offering the T2 bridge which offers a wider range of vibrato than traditional style six-point bridges. The T2 can also be easily immobilized for nineteen work.

Another difference between RX guitars and our more hard rock oriented guitars is a 22-fret neck. The 22-fret neck allows the neck pickup to be positioned further from the bridge. This provides warmer, fatter tone with the neck humbucker on. It also offers more overtones/vibrato when in the 2 and 4 positions of the RX's versatile Split 5 wiring. This is especially evident when playing with a clean tone.

All RX guitars (except the 750) feature solid, light American maple bodies for a quick attack, lighter low end and comfortable, balanced weight. The very deluxe RX750 features a padauk and mahogany body that combines an extremely warm tone with a very round, singing upper register.

Traditional single coil sound is easily achieved on the RX250, RX350, RX550 and 750. The RX650T and RX750 can tap sounds on the same control.



In 'base' new Talman guitars first bring to mind the vintage voices and styles of the past. A closer look inspires the thought that Talman guitars might have been created by the imaginative designers of the fifties and sixties, if they had today's technology at their disposal.

Talman guitars are made of Rayoncel, a composite wood that yields a sound reminiscent of the 60's popular Danelectro® guitars, which also used composite materials to achieve their unique funky tone. Both Talman TC and TV guitars are fitted with a comfortable vintage-style neck with Ibanez® modern All Access Neck Joint. And both use the very stable T2 tremolo. However, the two series have distinct differences in sound and style.

The TC series achieves its classic tone by using lipstick pickups mounted in a pickguard with a sound cavity under it. The center pickup is reverse wound which offers two completely noise-free positions using the 5-way selector switch. The result is a sound with even string-to-string

rise, a snappy attack, bright but full-bodied tone and excellent harmonics. Talman TC guitars are perfect for the player looking for a funky, bluesy sounding instrument that has a lot of character and presence.

TV series guitars are fitted with early 60's style mini-humbuckers. When combined with the center single coil and Ibanez® Split 5 wiring, these mini-humbuckers offer another unique tonal variation. When used by themselves in the 1 or 5 position, they offer a tight, well defined sound with a very focused mid-range and a slightly hotter output than a conventional single coil. A great guitar for the aggressive rhythm player who wants to cut through the mix.

Talman Series guitars are different (and funkier) than any guitar you've ever played. That's why one artist was inspired to call them "The Classic Alternative."

The original Ghostrider prototypes made by our LA Custom Shop generated so much enthusiasm that we even got phone calls from self professed "non-bonez players" asking how they could get one. With positive feedback like that, we knew had to make the Ghostrider part of the regular bonez line.

With its satin neck and humbucking pickups, the Ghostrider is a "descendent" of the famous bonez Artist models of the late 70's. The Ghostrider features a smaller, redesigned body and is made of older (rather than mahogany) for lighter weight and comfort. The Ghostrider's neck also has the same width and 24 3/4" scale length as the Artist, but its depth is slightly shallower.

The GR320 features a flat top with front and back body contours. The dynamic infinity rear pickup is mounted directly to the bridge. This, combined with the sat-in neck and older body, offers a fat, round, robust tone with plenty of sustain.

The GR320's carved maple top adds extra brilliance to both its tone and appearance. A conventional adjustable bridge/tailpiece provides variable string tension. The GR320's impressive good looks are further augmented by beautiful block inlays and stunning sunburst finishes.

What category of player was the Ghostrider designed for? The no category player who wants humbuckers, a sat-in neck and a fat, cheeky sound. With independent-minded artists like Shawn Lane, Alex Skolnick, and Ministry's Al Jourgensen and Mike Scaccia among its enthusiastic users, a more diverse group would be hard to imagine.



Today's GB10 is much the same as the original 1978 model, although improvements in production have resulted in an instrument that sounds better than ever. Floating pickups are still utilized for warmth, a thick top rejects feedback, and its small body is perfectly balanced for comfort. The GB100 shares these same features, but its body is 1/2" thicker. Its top, back and sides are crafted of flamed maple for an even more impressive appearance.

More recently, George Benson asked for a guitar built around a somewhat different concept than the GB10/100 guitars. The new GB5 has a lap-steel finished body with a spruce top, and Ibanez' warm Super SB pickups mounted in standard fashion. George had this to say about his newest instrument: "My last two albums were much more on the pure jazz side. And the GB5 is a pure jazz instrument; one that's made for the chordal and melodic style of playing. I consider it an honor to present an instrument to guitarists who are truly dedicated to the art of jazz music."
