





For players desiring a more traditional jazz box, George Benson's GJB also offers the **GB100S**, which features a solid hollow body with traditionally appointed pickups.

If you respect traditional jazz, but find yourself drawn to jazz of less traditional styles or volume, you should consider one of Pat Metheny's signature models. With maple back/sides and humbucking pickups, his guitars have all the hallmarks of the traditional jazz box. They're just not boxy. PM guitars are slimmer and they're also double cutaway. The neck joins the body at the 17th fret instead of the tried 14th so your fingers and the ideas that flow through them can travel beyond the borders of the traditional jazz guitar. Best of all, you can return home any time and the more conservative of your listeners will have no suspect where you've been.
