In this catalog, Prestige versions of our professional models can be identified by the Prestige symbol next to the neck description.

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

If you want a traditional jazz guitar, you should consider one of Pat Metheny's signature models. They're full hollow; they've got maple back and sides, handwinding pickups and absolutely flawless craftsmanship. In other words, everything you need to achieve the pure tones of the traditional jazz box. If you don't want a jazz guitar that's traditional, you should consider one of Pat Metheny's signature models. Yes, they still have jazz tones. They're just more PM guitars are cleaner and there's also double cutaway. The neck joins the body at the 17th fret instead of the traditional 16th so your fingers will travel effortlessly beyond the confines of the traditional jazz guitar.


